APPLICATION FOR INDUSTRIAL SEWER USE PERMIT

THE INDUSTRIAL USER MUST, AS PART OF THEIR APPLICATION FOR PERMIT:

1. Provide a plot of the property showing accurately all sewers, drains and house connections.
2. Provide plans and specifications covering any proposed changes to be performed under the permit.
3. Provide a complete schedule of all process waters and industrial wastes produced or expected to be produced at said property or premises, including a description of the character of each waste, the daily volume and maximum rates of discharge and representative analysis.
4. Provide the name and address of the person or firm who will be responsible for the performance of the work to be covered by the permit.
5. Show an internal and external piping schematic for all sanitary and industrial lines which discharge from the facility's site to the LCWSA system. Each line must be color coded to identify type and direction of flow. As piping is modified, the LCWSA will be notified in writing along with an updates schematic as previously described.
6. Provide a list of all the chemicals used in their process system and the characteristics of each. They must designate those chemicals and the amount that enters the LCWSA system. The amount must be entered in mg/L and submitted to LCWSA sixty (60) days from date of issuance of the new permit.
7. Schedule a "walk through" of the system with a LCWSA representative within two (2) months of issuing the permit. Any additional physical inspection will be scheduled as required.
8. Complete the attached Fast Report On Significant Industries and Industrial Chemical Survey forms.
9. If the Industrial User fails to obtain an Industrial Use Permit before discharging into the LCWSA Sewer System, they will be charged \$300.00 per day until they receive an approved Industrial Sewer Use Permit from the LCWSA.
